<b>At PRISON</b> You spend most of your life inside bars wanting to get out	<b>At WORK</b> You spend most of your time wanting to get out and go inside bars
<b>At PRISON</b> You must deal with sadistic wardens	<b>At WORK</b> They are called 'managers'
